

SUPERVISORS MINUTE BOOK 2023

June 8, 2023

The emergency meeting of the Board of Supervisors was called to order in the Auditor's Office at 9:00am by Doug Sorensen. Present were Doug Sorensen, Rick Thompson (via phone), Janell Remsburg, Lisa Frederiksen, Tyler Thygesen, Todd Johnson, Diana Munch, and Chassity Musfeldt.


Motion-Thompson Second-Sorensen to approve the agenda. Vote-all in favor.

The date for the FY23 Budget Amendment #3 public hearing was set and approved at the 6/6/23 meeting, but had not reviewed/approved any public notice prior to noon deadline/adjourning.

Discussion with Auditor Frederiksen on various amendment items and amounts-bonding professional fees charged, changes with public health, the E911 radios for schools and park (as well as potential E911 assisting with tower funding as done with other counties). Sheriff Johnson and E911 Director Thygesen also discussed radios/tower purposes for E911 funding potential—will discuss at next 911 meeting this summer. County budget amendment dollars will go ahead and fund the 911 radios for the two schools and Littlefield park so that they can use dispatch center to receive weather alerts and transmit emergency needs as well as other uses. Motion-Thompson Second-Sorensen to reschedule/set new date for the FY23 Budget Amendment #3 public hearing to June 27, 2023 at 10:00 am. Vote-all in favor. Motion-Thompson Second-Sorensen to approve the public hearing notice as presented by Auditor to be published in the June 16, 2023 newspaper. Vote-all in favor.

Motion-Thompson Second-Sorensen to have the county pay any fees for employees opting to do the CPR/AED training, including Clerk of Court employees. Vote-all in favor.

Motion-Thompson Second-Sorensen to adjourn at 9:20am. Vote-all in favor.
