You'll be eligible to receive a 25% tax credit for each donation, in addition to any federal tax benefits you may qualify for.

Every year, approximately \$4 million in Endow Iowa tax credits are set aside to distribute to those who make gifts to permanently endowed funds at a qualified community foundation, like *Audubon County Community Foundation*. The credits are available on a statewide first come, first served basis, so talk to your professional advisor today about how you can take advantage of this unique opportunity.
